## LOCAL RULES

- R & A Rules Apply**
- HEALTH & SAFETY**  
Members of the public on designated footpaths have priority on the course. The ball must not be played whilst they are in range.
- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**  
Beyond fences, hedges or white stakes bounding the course. Over the practice range net and beyond the white stakes to the left of the 1st hole. On or beyond the road to the left of the 3rd hole. The forecourt of the Clubhouse. The gardens beyond the white posts to the right of the 10th and 18th greens. Left of the 12th hole as defined by white stakes.
- WATER / LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**  
Water Hazards - all ponds, streams and areas defined by yellow posts.  
Lateral Water Hazards - drainage ditches running parallel with fairways and other areas denoted by red stakes. Bridges are part of the hazards.
- MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rules 24-1)**  
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**  
All artificial roads and pathways, fixed furniture (e.g. fairway bell, signage, benches), sprinkler heads, control boxes, drain covers and overhead wires. (A ball striking the wires on the 12th or 18th holes must be replayed - without penalty)
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR (G.U.R) (Rule 25)**  
The following areas are deemed to be G.U.R and relief MUST be taken: All areas encircled in white paint. Vehicle tracks or tyre marks. Temporary greens when not in play.
- STAKED TREES**  
If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the swing path of their intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped, without penalty, as per Rule 24-2b (immovable obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:**  
Match Play - Loss of Hole;  
Stroke Play - Two Strokes.
- OTHER LOCAL RULES**  
Please check Notice Boards in the Golf Shop, Gents and Ladies locker rooms for other Local Rules that may apply from time to time.
- GOLF BUGGIES**  
Only two buggies per tee time is permitted (4 persons). Buggies must be driven on pathways or in the rough. Please avoid driving on the fairway where at all possible. Buggies must not be driven within 10 yards of the green and bunkers.
